

USPA COVID-19 INTERCOLLEGIATE EQUINE WELFARE RELIEF PROGRAM

1. Program Overview

- USPA to provide funding for the feeding of horses owned by intercollegiate polo provided there is proof the USPA Member and/or their horses are in distress due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- USPA Intercollegiate Equine Relief Program Subcommittee may use a variety of resources to determine if there is a true necessity which may include member's or club's most recent bank statement, feed bill, the Henneke Body Condition Score, other player member's reference, or a veterinarian's note.

This program is not intended for individuals seeking financial support feeding their personal horses, this is designed for USPA Intercollegiate program horses participating in Intercollegiate polo.

2. Criteria:

- Intercollegiate Equine Welfare Relief Program applicant must be a USPA Member or an Active or Provisional Member Club in good standing.
- Intercollegiate Equine Welfare Relief Program request must be for horses that are owned by the intercollegiate polo team within the last year.
- Priority will go to programs who are student run and where the horses are not used for other programs (i.e. interscholastic teams, club events).
